

# **BROUGHAL IN THE COMMUNITY**

 Broughal Middle School is a Community School that works with St. Luke's University Health Network, Just Born, The Hispanic Center Lehigh Valley, and Lehigh University to provide support services to meet the needs of our families.

- H.E.A.R.T.S. Clinic is a free health and wellness clinic that serves the uninsured residents of Bethlehem and Fountain Hill. It is provided in partnership with Temple/St. Luke's and the Bethlehem Health Bureau.
- Broughal's Immunization Clinic serves Bethlehem residents and is provided in partnership with the Bethlehem Health Bureau.
- The Community Voices Clinic provides free mental health services to meet the mental health needs of individuals, families, and children by offering family therapy, individual therapy, group therapy, and community workshops.
- Lehigh University students assist
  Broughal students in their learning
  experience and the University includes
  Broughal in many of its community
  outreach programs. (Broughal students
  are paired with Lehigh student tutors
  and work with mechanical engineering
  students to design, build, and test
  prototypical race cars.)
- Broughal's Community Clothing Closet serves South Bethlehem community members and is provided in partnership with Fountain Hill Community Elementary School, Donegan Community Elementary School, the Hispanic Center Lehigh Valley, and Just Born, Inc.

# CONNECTING FAMILIES AND SCHOOLS

- Music Department The band is split up into four smaller groups: concert, jazz, marching band, and orchestra. Parents volunteer in the music department's four groups: jazz, marching band, concert, and orchestra.
- The Drama Club produces one play during the school year with the help of many parent and student volunteers.
- The PTO seeks volunteers to help with various events throughout the year, such as movie night or game night for the students.
- The Farm to School Program is designed to enhance local agricultural sustainability in an urban setting by integrating gardening activities into the core content curriculum at Broughal Middle School, increasing growth vields by incorporating sustainable growth-intensive practices, and demonstrating the feasibility and desirability of greenhouse agriculture. Parent volunteers help to plant, harvest and cook our produce, and maintain the greenhouse.
- Lehigh University provides Broughal with many services that benefit the community through their Community Service Office. The Lehigh CSO host Broughal Bowling, Spring Fling, Spooktacular, Parents Night Out, and Livin' La Vida Lehigh, all as outreach activities that Broughal families can enjoy.
