## How to Read Your Child's Middle School Schedule

East Hills Middle School runs on a 6-day cycle schedule. Next to each course, you will see how frequently the class meets. Some courses meet each day of the cycle (1,2,3,4,5,6), some meet on just even days (2,4,6), some meet on just odd days (1,3,5). Additionally, some courses meet all year, some meet for a 45-day marking period (M), some meet for a 30-day rotation (R), and some meet for a 60-day trimester (T).

## All Students (Team, Citizenship, Charger Block)

At the top of your child's schedule, you will find a "House/Team" assignment. Your child will have all core classes with students who are assigned to the same grade-level house team, just in different groups for each class. All teams are equally balanced in gender, race, academic ability, special services, support needs, and elementary schools (for 6th grade only).

All students are scheduled for Citizenship (this is your child's homeroom where your child will report each day and will engage in *Leader In Me* lessons) and Charger Block (this is where students will engage in interventions, enrichment, etc.) each day.

## Core Courses

All students are scheduled for the following four academic core courses daily: English, Math, Science and Social Studies

## **Encore Courses**

All **6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade** students are scheduled for a marking period (45-day class) of the following related arts courses: Art and Music

All **6**<sup>th</sup> **and 7**<sup>th</sup> **grade** students are scheduled for a rotation (30-day class) of the following Encore courses: Family Consumer Science, Industrial Arts, and Technology

All **8**<sup>th</sup> grade students selected electives that are scheduled every other day (either Days 1,3,5 or Days 2,4,6) for a semester. These courses will be either Art, Family Consumer Science, Industrial Arts, Music, or Technology. Choir is also, an elective option but meets all year every other day.

Students with a GIEP will also be scheduled for an every-other-day Seminar class.

All students are scheduled for Health/Physical Education every other day (either Days 1,3,5 or Days 2,4,6).

Most **6th grade** students are scheduled for Exploratory World Language courses, which are 60-day trimester courses of Spanish, French, and German. Most **7th grade** students are scheduled for one world language course of either Spanish, French, or German. This course selection is based on each student's selection on last year's language form. Most **8th grade** students are scheduled for the next year of their world language course they had in 7th grade.

Students with an IEP may be scheduled for an every-other-day academic support class in place of world language with their special education case manager. This is the person to contact regarding IEP plans.
