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Frequently Asked Questions

What do I do if I have children at the primary AND intermediate level?

- € If you have children at both the primary and intermediate level and you would prefer to come in on the same day, please email the teachers directly. They will accommodate your schedule as best as possible if you provide at least one week's notice.

How do I schedule a class visit with a teacher other than a regular classroom teacher or specialist?

Additional teachers are listed below. Please contact them directly to schedule an observation day and time.

- € Mr. Lerch is available on Tuesday.
- € Mrs. Bethmann is available on Thursday afternoon.
- € Mrs. Herbold is at GW on Tuesday and Wednesday.

Please contact the teachers above to make an appointment prior to coming to the school.

What do I do if multiple sessions are listed?

- € You are welcome to attend one or all of the sessions.

What do I do if I cannot make it to GW during American Education Week?

- € Please contact your child's teacher to make an appointment for a different date.

May I visit my child during recess or at lunch?

- € No, parents and grandparents are not permitted to attend these daily activities.

What is my role when I visit the classrooms during American Education Week?

- € Teachers schedule their own activities during this week. Some teachers will follow their regular routine, while other teachers may plan special events such as plays, presentations, bingo, games, etc. You may be asked to participate in the events, or you may be asked to observe. Again, the day's activities are individual to each teacher.

What do I do if I need to speak to my child's teacher?

- € Please understand that this week's festivities are not intended to be parent/teacher conferences. There will not be time for parents to interact individually with teachers regarding academic progress, behavior, etc. If you need to speak with your child's teacher, please contact him/her to schedule a conference.

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
