How will my child access the curriculum?

Computer or Chromebook

Students who have a chromebook do not need a paper packet. Lessons and videos will be assigned online through the Clever app, Google Classroom, Wonders, First In Math.



May I borrow a chromebook for my child?

Contact your child's teacher. Date and times chromebooks may be picked up will be provided



What can I expect of my child's teacher? If your child has access to a computer, you can expect your child's teacher to:

- Connect with students at least once a week to say, "Hello" and check-in to see how students are doing
- Plan lessons for students to access online
- Share lessons and tasks each day
- Encourage student participation and engagement
- Communicate with families if students are not completing assignments

What is expected of my child?

Students are expected to:

- Engage
- Participate
- Complete Assignments
- Students have one week to complete the assignments
- Hold onto the paper packets until a date is given to submit it
- The estimated amount of time to complete work is 60 minutes each day:
 30 minutes for reading and 30 minutes for math
- Use BASD Chromebooks for learning purposes
- Take proper <u>care</u> of the Chromebooks
