- Provide after-school tutoring
- Purchase instructional materials
- Secure substitutes so staff can conduct learning walks to improve teaching practices so they can address students' academic needs and increase opportunities to learn
- Hire an additional ELL Instructional Assistant to meet the needs of English learners

Continuity of Services

Recognizing the impact the COVID-19 pandemic has had on the social and emotional, and mental health well-being of staff and students, Freedom and Liberty High Schools will use ESSER funds to sustain services to address these needs by continuing the following services:

- Mindfulness Training
- Implement "Check & Connect" a mentorship program to improve student attendance, student emotional-well being and achievement
- Sustain and expand the Wellness Center at both schools
