

# Drop Off Directions for Arrival at Nitschmann Middle School 2017-2018 School Year



#### **Eastbound on West Union Blvd**

Drop off your child in the cone lane between 10th & 9th Avenues. Pull all the way forward. Children should exit your vehicle on the passenger side. Students should then walk down West Union Blvd to 10th Avenue to cross at the crossing guard and walk up to the school. This is the same as last school year.

# **Getting to the Student Services Office**

To get to the Office Parking Lot during arrival, go to 11th Avenue, turn right onto Genoa St, then enter the lot. You will need to leave the same way until arrival is over.

#### **Westbound on West Union Blvd**

Drop off your child in the cone lane between 8th & 9th Avenues. Pull all the way forward. Children should exit your vehicle on the passenger side. Students should then walk down West Union Blvd to 10th Avenue to walk up to the school. Please note this was the "old bus lane" last year.

# **Blockades (Show in RED)**

9th Avenue, 10th Avenue, and Genoa Street will be blocked off from 7:00am to 8:15am & 2:45pm to 3:15pm. This will also occur during Summer Band Camp & Band Drop Off.
