



## **Kim Donatelli Scholarship Application**

### **ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP:**

The Kim Donatelli Scholarship was established in memory of Kim Donatelli, a 1981 graduate of Freedom High School, and a former teacher in the BASD for 22 years.

### **AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:**

Up to \$2,000 will be awarded for the first year, and an additional \$500 will be awarded for the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th years.

### **QUALIFICATIONS AND ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES:**

Awards are available to any graduating Freedom High School senior planning to pursue a higher education degree in Education. A 3.23 grade point average or above is required.

### **CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:**

Students must submit a 2-3 minute video (preferred), or write a personal essay that includes educational goals and why this scholarship is important and essential to them.

The scholarship award is a check payable to the college or university of those selected to receive the award. The 2nd, 3rd, and 4th year payments will be made only after confirmation of enrollment at a college or university.
