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DIRECT SERVICES

Direct services are ways I support student performance (academic & behavior) directly with students.

INDIRECT SERVICES

Indirect services are ways I support student performance (academic & behavior) indirectly with students.

CLASSROOM LESSONS



Social-emotional learning curriculum created to teach children self-regulation and emotional control.

Social-emotional learning curriculum created to teach children how to build positive relationships, manage emotions, and meet goals.



COUNSELOR'S OFFICE

- Individual Sessions
 - Help students one-on-one with presenting problem
- Peer Conflict Restorations
 - Help two or more students with friendship/peer conflicts
- Lunch Bunches
- Monitoring students daily (cafeteria, hallway, recess)

ATTENDANCE

- Excused Absence - a written note was provided to the school within three days of the absence
 - allowed up to 10 in a school year
- Non-cumulative Absence - documentation from a doctor or other outside agency was provided to the school. Absence is not held against record
- Unlawful Absence - neither a written note nor documentation provided
 - **Student Attendance Improvement Plan** at 6 unlawful absences

If a student shows academic or behavior concerns, they are referred to the SAP process, which is a team approach to finding solutions.
