SUBJECT: Senior Activities - End of the Year - Commencement

- Wednesday, May 22 - A complete check of all textbooks by subject teachers to establish correct ownership and to provide payment for any lost or damaged textbooks. Textbooks will be collected when the student reports to the site where he/she takes the final examination.
- Thurs., 5/24, 5/28, 5/29 - Final Examinations (See Final Exam Memorandum)
- Thursday, May 30 - Review of examinations. This must be coordinated with the individual instructor since school for underclassmen will still be in session.
- Thursday, May 30 - Emergency examination make-up module. If, for any valid reason, a pupil could not take an examination when scheduled and it could not be rescheduled prior to end of the examination sequence, an opportunity on an emergency basis, will be provided to make up the exam. Students should note that an emergency exam make-up can only be scheduled by Mr. Cecchini, Mrs. Sage or Mr. DiBilio in Office 101.
- Friday, May 31 - Seniors who will not graduate will be notified by SSC 207 and Office 101.
- Tuesday, June 4 - 7:30 - 8:15 AM - Senior breakfast in cafeteria
- 8:30 AM - All graduating seniors report to the gym for the first of three (3) commencement practices.
- Wednesday, June 5 - 7:45 AM - All graduating seniors are to report to the gym for the second commencement practice. They will pick up their caps and gowns, report cards and all commencement tickets at the end of practice.
- All financial obligations must be paid by 2:30PM. Any student who does not meet their financial obligation will not participate in our graduation ceremony. Students not participating in the graduation ceremony will be able to pick up their report cards and diplomas on Friday, June 7, 2019 at 8:00AM.
- Thursday, June 6 - ARRIVE - 8:00 AM - All graduating seniors report to the Stabler Athletic and Convocation Center for the third and final practice starting at 8:30 AM. If you need transportation, contact SSC 207 by Friday, May 31 at 10:00 AM.
- 6:00 PM - Class officers, student council officers, class speakers, and valedictorian report to Stabler.
- 6:15 PM - All graduating seniors report in caps and gowns to the Stabler Athletic and Convocation Center.
- 7:00 PM - Commencement
- Diplomas - During the commencement ceremony, all seniors will receive their diplomas.
