KEYSTONE EXAMS

BASD high schools are still required to administer Keystone Exams. Students who are scheduled to take one or more Keystone Exams will receive a separate letter with specific testing information. The Algebra, Literature, and Biology Keystone Exams will be administered on January 27, 28, & 29, 2021. Only students taking a Keystone Exam will report to school. **Testing students will remain in school for the entire day.** All other students will have asynchronous assignments provided by their teachers. Twelfth grade students **do not** need to take Keystone exams. Please refer to the information below for the schedule after testing.

FINAL EXAMS

Due to the significant educational disruption caused by COVID-19, no final exams will be given at the high schools during the 2020-2021 school year. Days normally used for the administration of high school final exams will now be used for instruction.
