

School Profile

Freedom High School

Freedom High School has an enrollment of nearly 2,000 students in Grades 9-12 and is one of two high schools in the Bethlehem Area School District. Freedom is in the northeastern section of Bethlehem and was built in 1967. Subsequently, additions have included a Science Wing, 11 new classrooms, a fitness room, an aerobics room, and a state of the art gymnasium that was built and dedicated in 2006. This is a comprehensive, four-year high school accredited by the PA Department of Education. A vocational and technical education is available at the Bethlehem Area Vocational Technical School. Finally, the attendance catchment for Freedom includes a portion of Northeastern Bethlehem, South Bethlehem, and all of Bethlehem Township.

Activities + Athletics

All co-curricular activities are an integral part of our school community. Students have the opportunity to participate in over 35 organizations and 23 varsity sports. Freedom athletic teams compete in the East Penn Conference. Sports include: field hockey, baseball, softball, cross-country, track and field, volleyball, basketball, golf, lacrosse, wrestling, rifle, swimming, soccer, cheerleading, football, and tennis. A sampling of clubs/extracurriculars include: Anime Club, Art Club, Chess, Debate Team, Environmental Awareness Team, French/Spanish/German Club, Freedom Forum, Student Government, Yearbook, Science Olympiad, Scholastic Scrimmage, and Theater Company.

Dual Enrollment

Many students participate in dual enrollment programs (both in-person and virtually) offered at local colleges and universities including: Northampton Community College, Temple University, Lehigh University, Moravian University, Lafayette College, East Stroudsburg, and DeSales University. There is also an Academy for Medical Sciences offered at BAVTS which partners seniors with Lehigh Valley Health Network and St. Luke's University Health Network. Career Pathways Offered at Freedom:

BASD Purpose of Grading Statement

The purpose of grades is to communicate with students and parents/guardians about students' achievement towards specific goals. With a focus on student growth, grades are intended to be used as feedback to guide timely improvements and offer enrichment opportunities. Academic support factors are reported separately from the achievement grade.

Academic subjects meet five days per week for periods of 85 minutes for one semester. There are two marking periods each semester. Students receive an Achievement grade for each course which ranges from A+ to C- calculated as follows: two marking periods at 40% of grades for each and 20% for the final examination. The standard for passing is an Achievement Grade of 70%.

In addition to the Achievement grade, students receive Academic Support Factor grades for engagement and responsibility; 3 - meets expectations, 2 - approaches expectation, 1 - does not meet expectations. Academic Support Factor rubrics can be found on the school website. Honors courses and Advanced Placement courses as noted on the transcript receive one additional grade point unit (A=5.0, B=4.0, etc.). While weighting is used to determine rank in class, the final recorded grade on the transcript does not reflect the assignment of the extra weight.

Class rank is computed at the end of each semester for all students with an official class rank at the end of each school year. Exempt from rank is Community Service. All students are ranked together by grade.
