

Parents/Guardians:

If you are dropping your child off at school, it is very important that you drop your child off at the car rider entrance at the school parking lot at the back of the building. We understand that the line can be rather long; however, we are doing the best we can to keep the line moving quickly. Again, please do not drop your child off in the bus loop lane. Please do not pass through the cones on either sides of the bus loop to drop your child off and have them run across the bus lane. Our main priority is safety.

Also, please do not park along the walker entrance loop. You are allowed to park on Monroe Street to walk your child to the walker entrance if you decide to walk them to the door.

You will also see the Freemansburg Police Department out assisting with arrival/dismissal.

Chromebook Repair/Replacement Costs

GoGuardian

GoGuardian is a Chromebook management solutions software intended to try to keep students safer online and make teaching more efficient. The Bethlehem Area School District uses GoGuardian to filter and monitor websites that students visit in order to attempt to block inappropriate material on the Internet and to assist classroom teachers in keeping students on-task and engaged. While BASD uses GoGuardian as a tool to try to protect students from inappropriate Internet content, BASD does not guarantee that students will not be able to access any inappropriate material on the Internet.


