Dear BASD Families and Employees,

I am writing to share an update about a new state requirement related to school safety communication. This information is intended to keep you informed and to clarify what you may see in future notifications from the District.

A new law, **Pennsylvania Act 44 of 2025**, took effect last week. The law requires school districts to notify parents/guardians and employees whenever school administration or staff respond to an incident involving a weapon on school property, at a school-sponsored event, or on district transportation. It is important to note that due to privacy protections built into the law, schools are limited to sharing only the required notification language and cannot provide additional details or personally identifiable information. This ensures compliance with state and federal laws, including FERPA, and protects the privacy of students and staff. 
