



Dear Liberty High School Students and Families.

We are writing to inform you of an important update to our district's Personal Electronic Device Policy, effective May 19, 2025, for the upcoming school year. This revised policy aims to create an optimal learning environment for all students by minimizing distractions and fostering greater focus during instructional time.

In today's interconnected world, we recognize the role personal electronic devices, including cell phones, play in daily life. However, extensive research and our own observations highlight the significant impact these devices can have on student engagement, concentration, and academic performance when used inappropriately during school hours. Our goal with this updated policy is to cultivate a learning environment where students can fully engage with their teachers and peers, absorb information more effectively, and develop essential focus skills.

The updated policy for cell phone use is as follows:

For Students in High School (Grades 9-12):

- Cell phones must be silenced and stored away during all instructional times (e.g., classes, labs, study halls).
- · Students will be permitted to access and check their cell phones during designated transition times between classes and during their assigned lunch periods.
- Similar to our K-8 policy, we encourage parents to contact the school office in case of an emergency during instructional time, and we will relay messages to your child.

We believe these adjustments will significantly enhance the learning experience for all students by reducing distractions and






GOALS OF LHS WELLNESS CENTER & SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING (SEL)
