HOMEWORK, QUIZZES AND TESTS

Students can expect homework to be provided 4-5 nights a week. Homework can be in paper format or on-line. Weekly quizzes and an assessment at the end of each topic will be included.

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

General Rules:

Students are expected to come to class with the required materials and completed homework every day. Late homework is not accepted for full credit. If a student is absent from school, they are allowed a day for each day they are absent to complete and turn in work. Tests and quizzes should be completed within 5 days of the absence. Absences for early dismissals, band lessons and other similar circumstances are not considered absences from school and students should get the homework assignment prior to leaving for the day.

Grading Policies:

Classes are graded on a total points system as follows:

Homework = approximately 20%

In-Class Assignments = approximately 10%

Quizzes/Projects = approximately 30%

Tests = approximately 40%
