We will be discussing courtroom procedures and vocabulary. Math: All math classes have unit tests this week. Period 8 is taking theirs on Monday, Periods 1, 2 and 5 are Thursday, and Period 7 has their test on Wednesday. The focus of the next unit for all classes is solving equations. Geography: We continue to study how the United States experienced both growth and conflict after the American Revolution and eventually emerged as a world power. There will be a quiz on US History on Friday. We will also be taking a deeper look at the Constitution. One more thing.... GO EAGLES!
