Students in period 3 are working on movie analysis with *The Conspirator*. They are comparing and contrasting based on our novel *Manhunt*.

They will also have a notebook quiz on Thursday. Students in period 8 are working on reading chapter 3 in *The Contender* and have a guided packet of interactive questions that should be answered after reading the chapter. These will be checked and graded. These students will have a notebook quiz on Wednesday. History Classes analyzed primary and secondary documents from the Salem Witch Trials as they write text-based response essays. We will also finish our colonization unit studying how geographic location played important roles in economic and population development and growth throughout the 13 colonies.
