Academic Team Updates

Team Lafayette (6th) (Twitter [@NMSLafayette](https://twitter.com/NMSLafayette)) This week 6th grade students completed the PSSA testing. On Friday, we held an Earth Day event. All 6th graders planted flower seeds in empty 2 liter bottles. They will continue to collect data on the growth of the flowers and complete two well developed paragraphs about what they observed. Students also did a variety of Earth Day activities for much of the day. In social studies class, Lafayette is studying the country of Egypt, and in math we are studying equations.

Each student will research a topic from the book for a speech to be delivered on Friday. **Geography** - Students are learning about the construction of the Panama Canal and why it is important to diversify a country's economy. Later in the week we will begin our unit on South America. **Science** - We will know by Tuesday....where the most bacteria are lurking at the new NMS...the formal lab report on our hunt for microbes will be due Thursday evening to be submitted on google classroom. **ELA** - phrases quiz on Tuesday (noun phrase, verb phrase, prepositional phrase). **Math** - Periods 1,2,5 and 7 have a quiz on Tuesday on circumference and all the area formulas we have used. Period 8 has their Unit 10 geometry test on Wednesday.

We will read and discuss to p.66 in *Fahrenheit 451*. Science: We will be learning about energy conversions in the world around us. There will be more energy drawings for students to get signed after we cover them together. We will have a lab on energy generation/conversion that will definitely link some of the prior information together. There will be a quiz next Friday on Energy types. An Energy Sales project will also begin the following week. Math 8 classes are beginning to learn about systems of equations. Algebra 1 classes are going to start learning about operations with polynomials. History classes will finish the American Revolution unit, the unit test will be on Friday April 27th.

They will have a notebook quiz next Friday. Also, we will be working on analyzing a poem for a reading and social studies grade. Students in period 3 have started reading *Fahrenheit*. They are each assigned a book from the library to take home to complete homework. All students should be keeping up with the questions. Additionally, these students are still presenting current events and have a media log due Sunday night. Students in period 8 are working on their Contender projects that are due Monday. They will be presenting these on Monday as well. In History, we will take a look at the Declaration of Independence and it's ties to Thomas Paine's Common Sense. Students will be working on their Declaration Writing Assessment and will be choosing a signer to research. In our 2018 version of the Dating Game (from the 1970's), students will be taking on the persona of their DOI Signer. All Math 8 sections - Unit 7 Pythagorean - Book work, IXL and Math XL assignments and Quiz. Algebra 1 - Unit 7 Polynomials - Book work, IXL and Math XL assignments and Quiz. 10 more days to bring in the Hershey Form and payment. Late payments and forms will not be accepted.
