## Reading your Nitschmann Middle School Tentative Schedule

Nitschmann Middle School runs on a 6 day cycle schedule. Next to each course, you will see how frequently it meets (some are $1 / 2 / 3 / 4 / 5 / 6$, some are $1 / 3 / 5$, some are $2 / 4 / 6$ ).

At the top of your child's 2018-2019 tentative schedule, you will find a "House/Team" assignment. Your child will have all core classes with the same group of students on their grade level team, just in different groups for each class.

## Organizational Courses

All students are scheduled for Citizenship (homeroom where your child reports each morning when arriving at school for attendance) and LEAD (our Leader in Me program instruction, which meets 2 x per cycle).

## Core Courses

All students are scheduled for the following academic core courses, which meet daily:

- English Language Arts (6, 7, or 8)
- Reading ( 6,7 , or 8 )
- Social Studies (6, 7, or 8 )
- Science (6, 7, or 8 )
- Math (See below)

All students are scheduled for either Math (MA6002/MA7002/MA8002) or Math Advanced
(MA6001/MA7001/MA8001 is Algebra 1). This course is a tentative placement. No changes will be made by administration until approximately 30 days into the school year to allow teachers to get to know their students, collect data, and confirm the summer placement for all 6th grade \& new students. 7th \& 8th should be continuing on their current math course program, which was established in 6th grade.

## Encore Courses (Formerly called Related Arts Courses)

All students are scheduled for six, thirty day rotations of the following encore courses:

- $\quad$ Art $(6,7$, or 8$)$
- Family/Consumer Science (6, 7, or 8)
- Engineering Fabrication \& Design (6, 7, or 8)
- Integrated Art or Intergrated Music (6, 7, or 8)
- Music $(6,7$, or 8$)$
- Technology (6, 7 , or 8$)$

Students with a GIEP will be scheduled for an every-other-day Seminar class.

- All students are scheduled for Health/Physical Education every other day (either $1 / 3 / 5$ or $2 / 4 / 6$ )
- Most 6th grade students are scheduled for Exploratory World Language courses, which include a 60 day rotation of Spanish, French, and German. Most 7th grade students are scheduled for one world language, Spanish, French, or German. This course selection is based on student prioritized ranking of their choice in language from May. Most 8th grade students are scheduled for one world language, Spanish, French, or German. This is a continuation of their 7th grade world language course.

- Students with an IEP may be scheduled for an every-other-day Academic Support class..
