This week in social studies we continued with geographic vocabulary terms. Mrs. Hackman is giving a map terms quiz on Thursday, 9/20. In math students worked on IXL. Today in science students learned about hurricanes and were given updates on Hurricane Florence. Mr. Ortwein is giving a test on Tuesday, 9/18, on lab equipment. Please monitor your child's planner to make sure they are completing their work.

The t-shirt order forms are due by Tuesday, September 18. **ELA-** Periods 1, 2, 5 & 8 - We are working on building background for our Holocaust Unit. Students will receive Vocabulary List #1 on Monday. The quiz will be 9/25. Period 7 - Students are working on an interview project for the short story "Amigo Brothers". Students will receive Vocabulary List #1 on Monday. The quiz will be 9/25. **SCIENCE-**We will be practicing our volume measurements with a rainbow lab on Monday. **MATH** - All classes are continuing to work on a unit on rational numbers. Periods 1,2,5 and 7 have a quiz Tuesday on adding and subtracting integers (no calculators allowed). Period 8 will have a

quiz Friday on Sections 1-1 - 1-5. Expect students to have homework in math almost every day, all year. Most students are demonstrating responsibility in this area, but others are earning zeros. **Reading-** First book reviews are due September 28. Eighth period will read Wonder and discuss characters and setting. We will be reading The Boy in the Striped Pajamas in period 1,2,5 and study characterization and setting elements. **Social Studies-** We will have a continent and ocean quiz Monday 9/17.

Team East Stroudsburg (8th) (Twitter @NMSTeamESU) Monday is Constitution Day - 231 year. Students will be working on Supreme Court cases that deal with schools. Tuesday will be a lesson on growth of slavery in Jamestown and the effects that can still be seen today. Reading classes will finish Reflections on the Civil War and Lincoln: A Photobiography as we continue to build background knowledge on the Civil War. All math students will be having their first quiz by Monday, 9/17. Please encourage your kids to study as they need to at home. They are welcome to use online resources as well as their textbooks.

Team Northampton (8th) (Twitter @TeamSpartanNMS) Over the next two weeks, History classes will be using PearDeck to investigate the Jamestown colony, with specific interest in leadership, economics and government. Historical Iconic Image Google Slide Projects will be due Tuesday the 18th. In ELA this week, we will continue reading “The Speckled Band” and will engage in close reading analysis. In our word crimes unit, we will be exploring the uses of the noun. In Reading, we are working on our nonfiction unit and will read some short stories as well as pre-reading activities for our novel, *Chasing Lincoln’s Killer*. We will continue to work on citing text-based evidence and using our critical thinking skills. Please check your Schoology class for updates, announcements, assignments and any handouts used in class. In Algebra 1, students will be Solving Literal Equations, Inequalities, and Absolute Value Equations and Inequalities. In Grade 8 Math, students will work with Properties of Exponents. Students will continue to use both the IXL and Math XL programs. All students will take a Math Diagnostic Test using IXL. Please continue to check Schoology for all assignments, assessments and due dates. In Science we will be beginning a unit on an Introduction to Matter specifically focused on Elements Compounds and Mixtures.

Counseling Corner (Kehler, Litak, Hipp)

A friendly reminder to parents about all of us working together to teach personal responsibility, time management, and organizational life skills to students:

Please remember that the Student Services Office discourages parent drop-off of items*. As children grow, it is an important life skill to come to school/work prepared for the day. It is important to minimize class disruptions for pick-up of items to not interrupt the educational environment.

If students receive a drop-off at school, they will be called out of class to pick-up the item and will be required to meet with their grade level counselor regarding taking personal responsibility for coming to school prepared and ready to learn. Students with multiple drop-offs may receive a call home with a personal reminder that this practice is discouraged.

You, as the parent, can choose to remind your child that the office discourages drop-offs and allow them to learn through the natural consequences of their actions. In the big picture, they will not starve, fail out of school, or miss all of gym/athletics. However, they will learn to take more responsibility in their daily living, which is the ultimate goal. (*as usual emergencies are always honored)
