MATH - Periods 1,2,5 and 7 are beginning Unit 3, which focuses on percent problems. Period 8 is continuing to work with percents, learning about percent change and error, as well as mark-up and discount. All students are invited to enter The Hardest Math Problem contest from Scholastic (but I think they're exaggerating with the name just a little bit). The deadline to submit your entry to Miss Novatnak for extra credit is this Friday, 11/16. Students who submit correct answers will have the opportunity to answer Question 2 in January and potentially win prizes like a laptop of \$5,000. Reading- Character and setting quiz on Monday. Social Studies- We will be starting our United States/ Canada unit in November. Our first quiz will be labeling the states in the Northeast Region of the U.S on Wednesday 11/7.

Students will be introduced to the Oral History Project: students will have to interview a person 50 years older than themselves. Family and friends are best. In Reading, we are continuing our nonfiction unit with *Manhunt* and Chasing Lincoln's Killer. Students all have their own copy of the novels and are expected to bring them to class every day. There is a grade assigned for being responsible and bringing all materials to class. We will continue to work on citing text-based evidence and using our critical thinking skills. Students just set up our CLK museum in the library for all to see. Please stop by the library during conferences to see what awesome artifacts our students created. In periods 1,5,& 7, we are working on a poster project that will be due next week. In Period 3, we read an abridged version of Macbeth and analyzed the tragic Shakespearean play. In Period 8, we are continuing reading in the text and working on critical thinking questions. Please continue to check your Schoology class for updates, announcements, assignments and any handouts used in **ALL classes.** In Algebra 1, students will review for their Unit 2 Test. The Units 2 Test will be broken up into two days, Thursday and Monday. In Grade 8 Math, students will be working with slope and y-intercept, graphing linear equations in Slope Intercept Form and writing equations in Slope Intercept Form. Students will continue to use both the IXL and Math XL programs. Please continue to check Schoology for all assignments, assessments and due dates. In Science, we will be





exploring Metals, Nonmetals and Metalloids. We will be having a Chapter 3 test next week. Please be sure your child is writing in his or her planner to stay on top of their course work.
