GoGuardian Web Filtering & Monitoring (Mayes) In an effort to continuously improve our methods and procedures for protecting your children against any inappropriate material on the Internet, our District is piloting a software called GoGuardian. GoGuardian is a filtering and monitoring software that allows the District and individual classroom teachers to identify the websites students should be visiting for instructional purposes. GoGuardian assists the District and individual classroom teachers in keeping students on-task and engaged to reach their highest potential. GoGuardian is set up to filter and monitor only during the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and only on District Chromebooks.

Munro stories include "The Open Window", "The Mouse", and "Sredni Vashtar." Terms to be applied are foreshadowing, theme, irony, and symbolism. -- We are beginning Unit 2 in vocabulary. Lesson 6 sentences and definitions are due on Thursday, 11/8 and the vocabulary quiz is on Friday, 11/9. **Science (Mr. Pearson)** - This coming week students will begin learning about the scientific method, which is the procedure scientists use to solve problems. Students will be getting a vocabulary list for the chapter this week and then will have a vocab quiz on the words and definitions next week.

We will continue our narrative writing unit. <u>SCIENCE</u>-We will begin learning about the parts and use of the microscope this week. There will be a quiz on characteristics of life on Thursday 11/8. <u>MATH</u> - Periods 1,2,5 and 7 will have their unit test on Friday. Period 8 will have a quiz on Thursday on sections 4-1 - 4-3. Expect students to have homework in math almost every day, all year. Most students are demonstrating responsibility in this area, but others are earning zeros. <u>Reading-</u> We will begin The Lottery in honor of the jackpots that I didn't win. We will begin reading and analyzing <u>The Outsiders</u> soon. We will begin with a quick study of the 60's. <u>Social Studies</u>- We will be starting our United States/ Canada unit in November. Our first quiz will be labeling the states in the Northeast Region of the U.S on Wednesday 11/7.





Team East Stroudsburg (8th) (Twitter <u>@NMSTeamESU</u>) History classes will be exploring the colonial regions on Discovery Education techbooks. Students will have to decide which colonial region they would have immigrated into from Europe. Reading classes will continue to work on maps and summaries of JWB's escape route. Examples of author bias will be found and discussed. Math 8 classes are beginning Topic 2. Algebra will be continuing to learn about the different forms of linear equations. Science: Students will be exploring different portions of the periodic table. They will be working on their element projects. QUIZ on the PERIODIC TABLE and ATOM STRUCTURE will be on Tuesday. The Element Project structure can be found on Schoology. Students are encouraged to make a copy on Google Docs and to fill it in as they go. Mr. Amen will give them time in class to work. Their presentations will be do by the 13th and students will present from the 14th to the 19th.

Team Northampton (8th) (Twitter @TeamSpartanNMS) - Please be sure your child has headphones so they can work independently in class viewing the techbook videos as well as using the embedded reader tools Discovery offers. History classes will be finishing their Colonial America Unit with the Southern Colonies - Unit Assessment to follow. In ELA this week, we will be studying plot and developing the plot of our narratives. We will then move onto introductions and begin drafting our narratives. We also study the difference between affect and effect. In Reading, we are continuing our nonfiction unit with Manhunt and Chasing Lincoln's Killer. Students all have their own copy of the novels and are expected to bring them to class every day. There is a grade assigned for being responsible and bringing all materials to class. We will continue to work on citing text-based evidence and using our critical thinking skills. In periods 1,5,& 7, we started the second marking period with a test and a notebook check. We will now continue reading in the text. Period 3 had a quiz on chapter 4 and are working on reading chapter 5 of the novel. Period 8 will have a test after we read chapter 6 (within the next week). Please continue to check your Schoology class for updates, announcements, assignments and any handouts used in ALL classes. In Algebra 1, students will review for their Unit 2 Test. The Units 2 Test will be broken up into two days, Thursday and Monday. In Grade 8 Math, students will be working with slope and y-intercept, graphing linear equations in Slope Intercept Form and writing equations in Slope Intercept Form. Students will continue to use both the IXL and Math XL programs. Please continue to check Schoology for all assignments, assessments and due dates. In Science, we will be exploring the Periodic Table. Outline and Stations Lab will be due on Monday. Quiz will be on Thursday. Please be sure your child is writing in his or her planner to stay on top of their course work. There is FREE HOMEWORK HELP at the Bethlehem Public Library with Moravian College and Lehigh University Students - take advantage of this!


