Reading classes are working on a poem about Paul Revere's midnight ride to align with history class. Students are learning how to annotate and analyze poetry. All students will be learning about Civil Rights and reading poetry, short stories, and creating their own poem during this unit. Algebra 1 classes will be finishing Solving Systems of Linear Equations and Inequalities (Unit 4 Test Wednesday) and start Unit 5 - Graphing Absolute Value Functions. Math 8th students will take their Unit 4 Test on Monday (1/14) and continue working on Solving Systems of Linear Equations.. In ELA classes, we will begin to discuss our informational writing concepts. We will focus on facts, opinions, generalizations, topic sentences, and supporting details. ALL classes have their interviews due on Friday, Jan. 25. Our trip to the Museum of the American Revolution is just around the corner - January 22nd and January 23rd!
