

Chromebook Repair/Replacement Costs

If a student's Chromebook needs to be repaired, the student should take it to the library and a service desk ticket will be entered for the Chromebook to be repaired.

Unless deemed otherwise by school administration, repairs will be addressed as follows:

- **First Repair** - The Information Services Department will repair. No cost to parent.
- **Second Repair** - Parents will be billed per the schedule below by the Information Services Department after repairing the device.
- **Third Repair** - Parents will be billed for a new Chromebook purchase.

Chromebook Repair Costs	
Battery	\$70
Broken/scratched screen	\$215
Case (includes keyboard & trackpad)	\$70
Charging port	\$30
Motherboard (requires new Chromebook)	\$444 (new Chromebook purchase)
USB internal board	\$15

Unless deemed otherwise by school administration, if a Chromebook or one of its accessories is lost, stolen, or completely irreparable the parent/student is responsible for the cost of a new Chromebook, new bag, or new charger as outlined below.
