SCIENCE: Get ready for your science on Balanced and Unbalanced Forces on Thursday and Friday! We'll be reviewing in class, but you also have notes to review. Start the marking period off strong!

In Algebra 1, students will take their Point Slope Form and Parallel/Perpendicular Quiz on Monday, and prepare for a Unit 2 Test (Thursday for A to L and E-Learners, Friday for M to Z).
