8th Grade Dance

1. **In order for a student to attend the 8th Grade Dance, they must attend school on Friday, June 3, 2022 for the entire day (8:05am-3:05pm).** Students who have a medical or dental appointment may be dismissed early, but must show a paper doctor's excuse from the medical or dental office to attend the dance at the door to Dr. Mayes. Students that do not have this excuse will not be permitted into the dance. There are no exceptions for hair or makeup appointments. School is our primary responsibility & commitment.
2. **Only Nitschmann Middle School 8th Grade students may purchase their own ticket wristband and attend the dance.** Ticket wristbands are \$10. A ticket wristband is required for entry. All ticket wristbands must be pre-purchased at school prior to the dance. Students cannot pay for entry at the door. No outside guests are permitted. Students are not required to attend in couples or with a date. Wristbands will be issued & worn home from school on Friday.
3. **Students are to be dropped off in the bus lane between 6:00pm and 6:45pm. Parents & guardians should take photos prior to drop off.** There will be no parking on Nitschmann property. We encourage you to take pictures at the Rose Garden or at home before coming to school.
4. **Doors will open at 6:30pm - Students must report to the dance no later than 6:45pm.** Students will not be permitted to enter the dance after 6:45pm. Students may not leave the dance prior to 9pm. Students often arrive early and take pictures with each other & faculty out front before coming in. Students may be excused if they are sick by Dr. Mayes & Dra. Sierra only.
5. **Students are expected to wear appropriate semi-formal attire to the dance and should review the BASD Framework for Citizenship.** If you have a question, it is better to ask first before the dance. Girls typically wear dresses/skirts/pants/blouses and boys typically wear suits/sport coats/ties/button down or polo shirts/shorts. Girls often bring a spare pair of shoes because they don't like wearing heels the whole time - flip flops are great!
6. **Students are responsible for their cell phones and personal belongings during the dance.** Administration accepts no responsibility for personal items during the dance.
7. **Students who violate the BASD Framework for Citizenship during the dance will be sent home immediately by the administration and will have additional consequences under the BASD Framework for Citizenship.**
8. **During the dance, music will be provided by a DJ and food will be provided by donations and the dance committee.** There is no need for any student to bring money to the dance, as all items are included in the ticket price. 9. **The dance is chaperoned by Nitschmann Middle School faculty & staff at all times.** Students are expected to follow the directions of all chaperones at all times. Students may not leave Nitschmann Middle School at any time. Students will be in the cafeteria and the porch.
10. **Parents should use all available parking at dismissal at 9pm.** The bus lane will be closed. Students will be escorted back to the Main Entrance. Please leave enough time to arrive, find a parking spot, and meet your child. Parking is limited, so use Union Blvd too!
