We are having some trouble at arrival and dismissal and we need your help to keep our kids safe!

- PLEASE BE AWARE around SG. A driver recently ran over our pedestrian sign in the middle of North Blvd after turning out of the SG exit. She was distracted by her phone. We are very lucky that the sign was hit, and not a child. We see distracted driving by many parents -- please focus on the road and your surroundings.
- PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY. We are having parents fly through our main entrance loop after dropping kids off for breakfast. Families are crossing in the crosswalk to walk up to the solarium -- please, please slow down!
- SUPERVISE YOUR CHILDREN CLOSELY at arrival and dismissal.

 Keep them right with you, especially when crossing or near an area
- DO NOT DROP YOUR CHILDREN OFF BEFORE 8:45: we have no supervision for them outdoors and we have kids playing too roughly.
- If you need help at arrival or dismissal time, please let us know. We want to keep you and all our kids safe.

We want your input on the BASD cell phone policy

The district is in the process of creating a K-12 cell phone policy for students. We'll talk about this at our PTO meeting, but I'd love any feedback you might want to share with me directly (ebabbin@basdschools.org). The proposed guidelines for the elementary level are:

- Upon entering the school building, the student will understand that using any electronic device

 other than their district-issued electronic device can, and often does, hinder the learning process.
- The use of electronic devices other than district-issued electronic devices within the school building is prohibited.
- Any electronic devices, other than District issued computers/ipad or electronic devices should be turned off and placed in student backpacks.
